

BEVELLED GLASS PROCESSING DISCLAIMER

Please Read Before Placing Your Order

Bevelled glass is a decorative processed product. Due to the nature of glass processing, variations may occur during manufacture and are considered normal within accepted industry tolerances.

EDGE FINISH

The width, angle, polish, and alignment of bevelled edges may vary slightly as a result of glass processing equipment, glass thickness, and manufacturing tolerances. Perfect uniformity across every edge and panel cannot always be achieved.

CORNER ALIGNMENT

The intersection of bevelled edges at each corner may display minor variations in alignment. This is an inherent characteristic of bevelled glass processing and is not considered a manufacturing defect where it falls within accepted industry tolerances.

VISUAL ASSESSMENT

Bevelled glass should be inspected under natural daylight or equivalent diffused lighting conditions from a minimum viewing distance of 1 metre and at an angle between 30° and 90° to the glass surface. Inspection outside these conditions may highlight characteristics that would not normally be visible during everyday use.

ACCEPTANCE OF PROCESSING CHARACTERISTICS

By placing an order with Tough Glass, you acknowledge that bevelled glass is a processed product and accept that minor variations in edge finish, corner alignment, and appearance are inherent characteristics of the manufacturing process and do not constitute defects where they fall within accepted industry tolerances.
